Policy Framework for the Year 2002

In the year 2002, ONCB has prepared the policy framework for opposing drugs problems as follows :

1. Management Policy

Planning/Budgeting

- Develop and support the policy of drug prevention and problem solving to be the national policy and provide the organization to direct the policy linking from the national level to local level.

- Develop the provincial plan and budget system to implement effectively on drug prevention and problems solving

- Develop the plan and budget system for drug prevention and suppression to be efficient in long term and short term as well as to develop the monitoring and evaluation system on the program/project of the drug prevention and suppression.

Information Technology

- Develop and set up the “watch list” system on the drug situation change to be part of the information support system used throughout the country

systematically and continually.

- Develop the fundamental drug information system in the village / community level.

- Manage and compile data and information on drug prevention and suppression of Thailand and foreign countries.

- Formulate the Information Technology Master Plan (2001-2003) on drug prevention and problems solving.

Human Resource Development

- Provide the personnel development on drug prevention and problem solving, both in the ONCB and agencies concerned continually, in order to accelerate the capacity of the officers.

- Create and develop the Instructors of the ONCB and agencies concerned to have evaluation and development on training program to be standard, and also to develop the new programs.



International Cooperation

Coordinate and support the implementation of the international cooperation along the border areas, and also encourage the cooperation in drug prevention and problem solving in bilateral and multilateral level.

Technical Support and Research

- Study and develop models of drug prevention and problem solving in educational institutions and communities.
- Disseminate and support continually the technical and research works to agencies and organizations concerned.
 - Analyze and research new drugs or other substances.

2. Drug Prevention Policy

- Conduct public relations to create drug awareness in all target groups about the danger and harm of drugs.
 - Encourage the government organization, non-government organizations, and people organizations to participate in drug prevention activities continually in the levels of community, educational institution and family.
 - Implement drug prevention and

problem solving in all target groups, especially community groups and youths in educational institutions

- Coordinate and support the drug prevention and problem solving activities that are major and urgent policy such as the anti- drug sports playground program, etc.

3. Drug Law Enforcement Policy

- Develop active intelligence systems and encourage the unity of intelligence systems to support the drug suppression of the agencies concerned.
 - Develop new techniques and procedures for drug suppression to be in line with the real situation.
 - Accelerate the implementation on prevention of the government officials from relating the drug offences.
 - Coordinate and monitor the scientific detection process and the destruction of confiscated drugs with agencies concerned.
 - Develop and improve narcotics control laws as a facilitator for effective drug problem reduction.
 - Accelerate the implementation on assets investigation and confiscation of the drug offenders under the Act on Measures for the Suppression of





Offenders in an Offence relating to Narcotics B.E. 2534 (1991) as well as develop the data system on the assets investigation case.

4. Drug Problems Solving Policy

Integrated Measure

- Mobilize the people's participation to fight against drug problem in the pattern of "State-Civil Alliance against Drugs" by distributing this campaign to all provinces.

- Conduct Anti-drug Campaign Projects to create positive attitudes of the people in communities, villages, districts and provinces.

- Accelerate the prevention and suppression of government officials who have become involved in drug offence.

- Encourage and promote the community network in drug problem solving by themselves in accordance with the real situation of each community.

Drug Treatment and Rehabilitation

- Encourage and coordinate a complete procedure of treatment and rehabilitation in the implementation both of the government and non-government organizations for all target groups.

- Support the establishment of the rehabilitation centre for drug addicts, The therapeutic community (T.C.) type to be nationwide and coordinate the treatment and rehabilitation for drug addicts under the Act of Rehabilitation for Drug Addicts B.E. 2534 (1991) by focusing on the monitoring of the implementation.

Narcotic Crop Control

- Survey and analyze data on narcotic crop cultivation areas.

- Coordinate and support the agencies concerned to eradicate narcotic crops in illicit cultivation areas.
